[Pride Toronto](#) takes place the weekend of June 28–30, 2024, which culminates the end of a full month of Pride events happening across the city. It's a busy time for so many, from performers and promoters to parade participants and partygoers. It can also be a bit overwhelming to some, so we've compiled a list of a bit of everything for everyone, from big-name parties to more intimate events, along with other recommendations. Also, for those who prefer to celebrate in a more solitude type of way, we've compiled a list of books, music, and movies to immerse yourself in without the crowds.

### **Pride Perspectives**

**My First Pride** was established to create an inclusive and welcoming space for individuals celebrating Pride for the first time. Be a part of Pride Toronto's My First Pride Parade Contingent, whether you're a newcomer to Canada or a new member of the 2SLGBTQIA+ community. The **Pride Sober Oasis**, located within Paul Kane Parkette, is a space to rest, relax, connect, and be replenished. Wherever you are on your journey, many different Sobriety Modalities

will be hosting meetings, including 12-Step and SMART Recovery—there will also be performances, games, and so much more. **Family Pride** celebrates the strength and uniqueness of 2SLGBTQIA+ families and children with face painting, a magic show, storytelling, etc., located on the grounds of Church St. School.

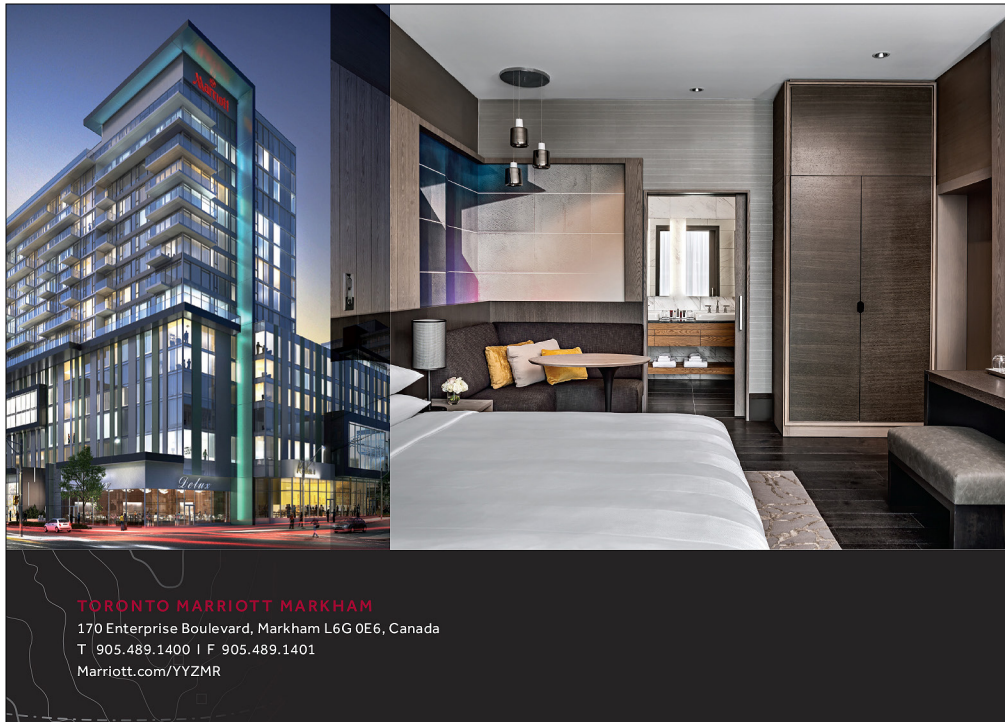
